



Summer Civics Initiative 2020 Application

PublicSquare’s Summer Civics Initiative is open to all undergraduates enrolled in a college or university in Santa Barbara County, as well as its current and former Student Fellows and Program Assistants. Underrepresented minority, first generation, and low-income students are especially encouraged to apply. The terms include:

- Secure an internship in a non-profit, government, social service agency or related field for Summer 2020
- Intern/volunteer a minimum 50 hours this summer in an unpaid or minimally paid position
- Submit the Summer Civics Application
- Submit your resume
- Submit a 250-300 word statement describing how your past academic, work, and volunteer experiences relate to your preferred internship and how you hope the internship will impact your professional and public service goals
- Fill out a quantitative survey and submit a 400-500 word statement at the end of the summer that reflects on the impact of the internship experience
- Receive \$750 stipend: A \$375 disbursement at the beginning of the internship and \$375 after completing the evaluations at the end of the internship
- **Application due: June 30, 2020**
