



# Fall Civics Initiative 2021 Application

PublicSquare's Fall Civics Initiative is open to all undergraduate students enrolled in or recently graduated from Santa Barbara or Ventura County colleges and/or undergraduate students residing and interning in these two counties for Fall 2021, as well as its current and former Student Fellows and Program Assistants. Underrepresented minority, first generation, and low-income students are especially encouraged to apply. The terms include:

- Secure an internship in a non-profit, government, social service agency or related field for Fall 2021
- Intern/volunteer a minimum 80 hours this fall in an unpaid or minimally paid position
- Submit the Fall Civics Application
- Submit your resume
- Submit a 250-300 word statement describing how your past academic, work, and volunteer experiences relate to your preferred internship and how you hope the internship will impact your professional and public service goals
- Fill out a quantitative survey and submit a 400-500 word statement at the end of the fall that reflects on the impact of the internship experience
- Receive \$1500 stipend: A \$750 disbursement after the first 40 hours and \$750 after completing the evaluations at the end of the internship
- **Application due: September 30, 2021**
